MAGNUSON, Donald Hammer, 1911- 1979

PAPERS, 1953-1962

Don H. Magnuson, a Representative from Washington, was born on a farm near Freeman, Spokane County, Washington, March 7, 1911. He attended public schools and Spokane University 1926-1928, and was graduated from the University of Washington in 1931. After graduation he worked as a harvester and then as a riveter in an aircraft factory. Later he was a newspaper reporter for the Daily Olympian and the Seattle Times, 1934-1952. He was elected to the 83d Congress on the Democratic ticket and to the four succeeding tickets, January 3, 1953 to January 1963, when he was defeated for re-election.

The bulk of the papers, consisting of correspondence, reports, financial materials, ephemera, etc., concern Magnuson's legislative career, 1958-1962. There is little material dating back to 1953, and there is little or no personal material.
