AMERICAN EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH ASSOCIATION

The American Educational Research Association (originally called "the National Association of Directors of Educational Research") was founded in New York in 1915. During the early period (1915-1919) it was primarily concerned with the testing of the educational achievements of students; however, as the organization expanded and the membership was increasingly dominated by faculty members from colleges of education, its research projects diversified. In 1931, the AERA became a department of the National Education Association and then in late 1960's again became an independent association.

The AERA publishes two journals, The Journal of Educational Research, begun in 1919; and the Review of Educational Research, first published in 1931.

The AERA materials in this collection consist of records from the Washington, D. C. office, ca. 1924-1975, the major body of the materials belong to the period of 1964-1968. Also there are the subgroups formed by the papers of the various past presidents of AERA. These are: Kenneth E. Anderson, 1955-1961; William Brownell, 1962-1965; John I. Goodlad, 1964-1969; Stuart A. Courtis, 1920-1939; J. Cayce Morrison, 1919-1954; Victor Noll, 1955-1960; Burdette R. Buckingham, 1914-1959; David Krathwohl, 1967-1969; and Guy Buswell whose subgroups contain only his scholarly writings.
