INVENTORY GUIDE

This collection represents the evolution and activities of the W.U. International Studies School from approximately 1930-70. During this time the School underwent a series of name changes, each indicating its more expanded role in foreign studies. It progressed from the W.U. Oriental Studies Department to W.U. Far Eastern Department (1942) to W.U. Far Eastern Institute (1946) to W.U. Far Eastern and Russian Institute (1949) to W.U. Comparative and Foreign Area Studies Institute (1972) to, finally, W.U. International Studies School (1978).

These records were, for the most part, created by the executive officer of the particular entity. The men were Robert T. Pollard (1932-39), George E. Taylor (1939-69), and Franz Michael (1942-64, as assistant director to Taylor).

The organization of the inventory is fairly straightforward. There are three correspondence series, all containing incoming and outgoing correspondence and the first series (chronological) containing both intra-university and general correspondence. In the General Correspondence series there are some folders containing the correspondence (internal and external) of faculty members. The Conferences and Conventions series contains records not only of University of Washington-sponsored conferences but also of conferences attended by W.U. International Studies School faculty. The Subgroups are likewise formed from W.U. International Studies School activities and faculty activities. At the end of the collection are some miscellaneous publications and two reel-to-reel tapes made by Professors Spector and Gershevsky.

An organizational change in the W.U. Far Eastern and Russian Institute in the late 1960's decreased the central responsibilities of the director's office by the creation of Area Studies programs within the W.U. Far Eastern and Russian Institute. These programs are more independent than the previous projects had been, and have taken on their own administrative lives. Two of these programs, W.U. Russian and East European Studies Program and W.U. South Asian Studies Program, now exist as separate accessions and all future accessions of these and other programs will be handled separately.

Also contained in this collection is information pertaining to the W.U. Far Eastern and Slavic Languages and Literature Department. This language teaching entity was created as a companion to the research and area studies orientation of the W.U. Far Eastern and Russian Institute. Its chairman was George E. Taylor and, consequently, its records are inseparable from those of the Institute.
